

Annual Bus Trip!

All WASH members are welcome to join us on a bus trip to **US Bank Stadium and Gibb Farm on Thursday, September 5, 2019**. In the morning we will have a guided behind-the-scenes tour of the US Bank Stadium where the Minnesota Vikings play. We will then we will bus several miles down the road to the Gibb Farm run by the Ramsey County Historical Society. Here we will get a guided tour which will take us back to the nine-teenth century pioneer and Dakota daily life. There will be costumed interpreters provide a glimpse into nineteenth century pioneer and Dakota daily life. The tour includes the pioneer soddy, Dakota summer bark lodge, tipi, farm animals and birds, and the one-room schoolhouse. It also includes a **homemade ice cream activity** which will serve as our afternoon snack before we leave for home.

We will charter a coach bus. The price for age 13 and above through adult is only \$25. Ages 5 to 12 are \$18. The fee includes the bus, US Bank Stadium admission and Gibb Farms admission (and homemade ice cream activity). This trip is only for those age five and older so please make other arrangements for those younger.

Please wear comfortable walking shoes, pack a picnic lunch including water to drink, and bring a quick snack to eat upon arriving at US Bank Stadium. *No food or drink will be allowed on the bus*.

We will meet the bus at in the Kandi Mall parking lot (near Kohl's entrance) by 7:00 A.M. We will load and return back to Willmar around 5:45 P.M. See the registration for the schedule.




